The six-part queer digital series depicts an eccentric Human Resources team as they navigate personal and professional struggles under the leadership of their high-maintenance director, Mitch Grosse (Colby Ryan). It is a workplace comedy that veers from the dramatic to the absurd.

It stars transgender actress Pooya Mohseni (Iranian-American transgender activist) as Alicia Castile, Anne Schroeder as Sarah Wilson, Steve Barkman as Brian Lambert and Colby Ryan as Mitch Grosse.

Released in June, a few days ahead of Ryan Murphy's groundbreaking series *Pose* - which comprises the largest LGBTQ cast in the history of scripted television series - *Grosse Misconduct*, likewise, puts transgender (Pooya Mohseni) and gay actors (Colby Ryan) front and center.

Grosse Misconduct is a web series inspired by the need for more LGBTQ inclusion in film. It offers a refreshing take on LGBTQ as all the characters are allowed to be people first.

Colby's aim in writing these characters was to create and celebrate work that better represents the full spectrum of the LGBTQ communities and to feature characters that are identifiable and relatable to all audiences.
